Elder Gideon, MFA, is a spiritual folk artist visualizing a rare oral tradition. He was trained at California State University, Sacramento, and L'Accademia di Belle Arti in Florence.

Gideon's intention is to make the invisible visible. His imagery evolves from mystical Judaism and Christianity. Through myriad materials and processes, he offers a way forward in contemporary life that is contemplative and integral. His icons, sculptures, and installations are sought by practitioners and collectors throughout the U.S. and abroad.

Gideon pursues the physicality of the sacred with forms that invite us to dream again and reimagine our whole selves which are often fragmented by modernity.
